Emergency Fire, Rescue and Ambulance Services

- 1) To answer 995 calls within 10 seconds, 95% of the time.
- 2) To respond to fire / rescue calls within 8 minutes, 90% of the time.
- 3) To respond to ambulance calls within 11 minutes, 80% of the time.

Fire Safety and Public Protection

- 4) To provide an outcome to Alarm Monitoring Services (DECAMS) Licence application within 7 working days, when application is open and submission is in order.
- 5) To provide an outcome to Fire Certificate application within 3 working days, when submission is in order.
- 6) To provide an outcome to Fire Safety Plan application within 5 working days, when submission is in order.
- 7) To provide an outcome to Temporary Fire Permit / Fire Safety Certificate application within 7 working days, when submission and site inspection are in order.
- 8) To provide an outcome to Temporary Change of Use application within 3 working days, when submission is in order.
- 9) To provide an outcome to waiver application within 7 working days, when submission is in order.

- 10) To provide an outcome to the Lodgement of Minor Alterations or Additions works application within the same day, when submission is in order.
- 11) To provide a reply to consultation by appointment within 3 working days; and written consultation within 7 working days.

Petroleum and Flammable Materials

- 12) To provide an outcome to Petroleum and Flammable Materials Import Licence application within the same day, when submission is in order.
- 13) To provide an outcome to Petroleum and Flammable Materials Storage and Pipeline Licence application within 19 working days, when submission and site inspection are in order.
- 14) To provide an outcome to Petroleum and Flammable Materials Transport Licence application within 3 working days, when submission is in order.

Community Preparedness

- 15) To conduct 400 Public Education and Community Programmes on emergency preparedness annually.
