
STOP THESE POTENTIAL
HAZARDS FOR A FIRE SAFE
COMMUNITY!

KITCHEN FIRE

- Cover cookware with lid or a wet cloth
- Turn off gas supply
- Call 995 for SCDF's assistance, if the fire goes out of control
- Avoid leaving cooking unattended
- Avoid pouring water into cookware



CLUTTERED CORRIDOR



- Ensure a minimum clear passageway of at least **1.2m**
- Call the Town Council for the removal of bulky objects
- Avoid discarding items along corridors, lift lobbies, escape passageways and staircases

RUBBISH CHUTE FIRE



- Do not throw lighted cigarette butts into the rubbish chute

If there is a rubbish chute fire, pour water down the chute until there is no more smoke!



WATCH OUT FOR THESE ELECTRICAL FIRE HAZARDS!



- Switch off electrical appliances when not in use
- Avoid overloading electrical outlets
- Frayed wires or damaged electrical equipment should not be used
