

FIRE SAFETY TIPS FOR PERSONAL MOBILITY DEVICE (PMD) & POWER ASSISTED BICYCLE (PAB)

- ✓ Purchase PABs with EN15194 certification and affixed with LTA's orange seal of approval



- ✓ Purchase registered PMDs with UL2272 Certification Mark

- ✓ Use a power adapter that carries the safety mark and is recommended by the manufacturer



- ✓ Charge PMD/PAB on a hard, flat surface to allow optimal dissipation of heat
- ✓ Regularly examine batteries for any damage or deformities such as bloating, corrosion or powdery residue

- ✗ Do not buy or use non-original batteries

- ✗ Do not charge the PMD/PAB immediately after use

- ✗ Do not tamper with, modify, or attempt to repair a device on your own

- ✗ Do not charge a PMD/PAB or its batteries near combustible materials or along an escape path

- ✗ Do not leave batteries or devices to charge unattended for an extended period of time or overnight
