SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES (NON-STAFF)

SCDF offers sponsorship for existing Polytechnic and Higher NITEC students.

► POLYTECHNIC SPONSORSHIP

- Offers payment of tuition, other compulsory fees and monthly allowance.
- All recipients are required to fulfil a bond period of 4 years.

► ITE SPONSORSHIP

- Offers payment of tuition, other compulsory fees and monthly allowance.
- All recipients are required to fulfil a bond period of 3 years.
- Recipients who subsequently attain a place at one of the local Polytechnics may be sponsored for their studies with an extended bond period of 6 years.

Be the source of courage and compassion. When you join the SCDF, you join the ranks of an elite team which courageously protects and saves lives and property for a selfless cause. As a Fire and Rescue Specialist, you will respond to emergency incidents and assume the role of incident commander. You will conduct fire fighting & rescue operation, fire safety enforcement and fire investigation.

CAREER DEVELOPMENT

After completing the Section Commander Course (SCC), you will be posted to a fire station as a Fire and Rescue Specialist. Your career can develop along two distinct paths: **Command Track** or **Specialist Track**.



ACCELERATED ADVANCEMENT

Good performing Direct-Entry Sergeants can look forward to accelerated advancement opportunities. You can be directly promoted to the rank of Lieutenant within the first few years in the Force (without a degree qualification).

PRE-ENLISTEES

For those who have not served their National Service, the Minimum Term of Engagement (MTE) scheme provides expert training, develops leadership skills and fulfils the National Service commitment.

TRAINING

Your route to becoming a Fire and Rescue Specialist begins at the Civil Defence Academy with the Section Commander Course (SCC).

The SCC will equip you with rescue and firefighting skills, fire safety knowledge and contingency planning proficiency. At the end of the course, you will take on the challenging role of a Section Commander in the fire station.

The five-month SCC training programme will cover:

- ▶ INCIDENT MANAGEMENT
- ▶ FIRE INVESTIGATION
- ▶ URBAN SEARCH AND RESCUE
- ▶ PRE-HOSPITAL CARE
- ▶ FIREFIGHTING
- ▶ FIRE SAFETY
- ▶ HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

TRAINING BOND

You are required to sign a two-year training bond. Should you terminate your service during the SCC or within the two-year bond period, a liquidated damage based on your individual monthly salary is payable.

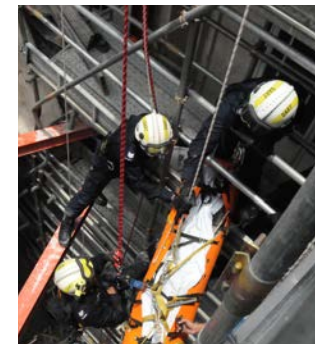

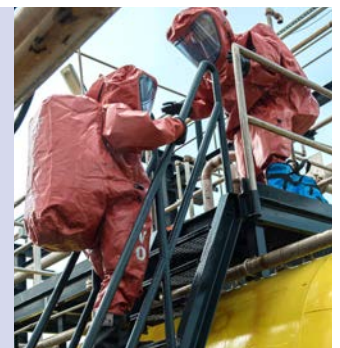


DISASTER ASSISTANCE AND RESCUE TEAM (DART)
