As the vanguard of our frontline, you will be professionally trained to be in control of challenging rescue incidents, and battling fire, chemical, biological and radiological threats with innovative and cutting-edge technology. You will be involved in policy formulation and implementation to keep Singapore a safe and emergency-ready nation. Mentorships, varied job exposure, and opportunities to participate in overseas missions and international learning exchanges will help to nurture your strengths — regardless of your career specialisation — and prime you for real-life challenges.

CAREER DEVELOPMENT

Your career will commence with the Rota Commander Course (RCC). After the RCC, you will be posted to a fire station as a Rota Commander for about two years. Subsequent postings will expose you to command, staff and specialist functions. These will help uncover your strengths and interests to guide your career path. We believe in grooming our officers as leaders. You can look forward to serving at different leadership levels as you rise through the ranks. Through our Talent Management Scheme, we nurture the aspiring into our next generation of helmsmen, who serve with pride and lead with both vision and passion.

TRAINING

Your route to becoming a Senior Officer begins at the Civil Defence Academy with the Rota Commander Course (RCC).

The RCC will equip you with rescue and firefighting skills, staff work knowledge, and contingency planning proficiency. At the end of the course, you will take on the challenging role of a Rota Commander in the fire station.

The seven-month RCC training programme will cover:

- ▶ FIRE INVESTIGATION
- ▶ URBAN SEARCH AND RESCUE
- ▶ PRE-HOSPITAL CARE
- ▶ FIREFIGHTING
- ▶ FIRE SAFETY
- ▶ HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

TRAINING BOND

You are required to sign a two-year training bond. Should you terminate your service during the RCC or within the two-year bond period, a liquidated damage based on your individual monthly salary is payable.
