## UPDATE OF PLANS FOR LEGACY LPG SYSTEM DROPPER LOCATIONS

Currently, every Petroleum & Flammable Materials (P&FM) storage licence application shall be accompanied by approved plans endorsed by a Qualified Person (QP). With the Fire Code amendments on 1<sup>st</sup> Sep 2022<sup>1</sup>, the installation of LPG system **droppers** will be considered as fire safety works which requires plans submission. SCDF will check the location of droppers against the approved plans when we inspect for unauthorized fire safety works.

- 2. There are premises with existing droppers which are not captured in their legacy approved plans. To address this issue, LPG storage licensees will be given a one-time opportunity to update the legacy approved plans from the existing LPG manifold system up to the droppers<sup>2</sup>. The plans shall be endorsed by a QP and will only need to be submitted to SCDF Storage Risk Branch (SRB), along with the endorsed form (**Annex A**), as part of the licence renewal submission. Subsequent changes made to the LPG manifold, piping, or any part of the LPG system up to the droppers will require plans submission conforming to the latest Fire Code.
- 3. This exercise will take effect from 1<sup>st</sup> Mar 2023, with a 6-month grace period. To avoid business disruptions, licensees are urged to share the endorsed plans with SCDF SRB before the 6-month grace period expires. There will be no further extension beyond this grace period.
